Class Rules for BBT 9

-- **Be on time. When the bell rings, you should be in your seat and logged in.**

- If you arrive late and the door is closed, knock once on the door and wait quietly. Bring a note.

-- **Always have the following in your possession during class every day:**

- a working set of earphones (regular size to fit an iPod or mp3 player = 1/8" stereo plug)
- your network login ID and password
- your FHS Agenda book
- a pencil and a pen

(If you arrive without your earphones or network login username and password, you may be asked to wait outside the classroom, and you may receive a detention.)

-- **No food or drink is allowed in the computer lab.**

-- **During a presentation or question-and-answer time, only one person (teacher or student) will talk and the others will remain quiet and attentive.**

- Please listen carefully to answers given to another student. The teacher does not appreciate having to repeat instructions.

-- **Work quietly at your workstation and manage your time wisely.**

- Students must focus on their work and plan to meet deadlines.
- Students must access only web sites related to course work.
- Students are expected to be working quietly the entire period.
- Students are expected to remain in their seats, especially during presentations.
- If a student has an emergency and the teacher is unaware, then make your request quietly.

-- **If you have a question, you may quietly ask a student beside you. However, be aware that the student beside you may be incorrect. Be sure to verify the answer with the teacher.**

- Beware that some students have received incorrect advice and had to redo parts of their project.

-- **If an absence is planned in advance, talk to your teacher to plan for the missed work time.**

-- **Two or three times per week, extra help is provided for 30 minutes during lunch time.**

- This time is for working on BBT work only. Friends are not to be invited.

-- **Abide by the conditions in Policy 311 at all times.**

- Playing games is not considered a proper use of school resources.
