

Grade 10 – Poster Project

Create a poster of the shape you have chosen for your box project.

Remember:

Elements are the 'tools' you use.

Principles are what you 'do' with the elements.

Steps for Design Poster Project

1. Make a stencil containing 3 different sized outlines of your chosen object. (small, medium, and large)
2. Divide a large sheet of white paper into 6 even, equal sections or boxes.
3. In each box, work out an abstract design using the stencils of your chosen object.
4. Each box will contain repetition and will:
 - a. Emphasize one element of art
 - b. Demonstrate one principle of design
 - c. Not repeat any pair of elements/principles from another box
5. One box must have colour. One box may have colour. All others boxes must only use black and white.
6. Each box should be approximately 50/50 positive and negative. This means that each box should be "filled", "not empty looking" but not "over-filled".
7. Two boxes must have dark backgrounds. Two boxes must have light backgrounds. (Two boxes are up to you.)
8. The object must be used (stenciled) at least 10 times over the entire poster.
9. A key or legend must be provided showing what you have depicted. This must be on a separate paper that is taped to the back of the poster. Your legend will contain a sentence for each element and principle in each box and clearly explain what box is referenced and how the element and principle is demonstrated. (Total 12 sentences)
