Tournament Information:

- 1) Teams will be given a 10 minute on court warm-up if tournament is running behind. The warm-up will consist of a 5-5 attacking warm-up and teams must serve (it they wish) within their 5 minutes. The 10 minutes will start once the court is cleared from the previous game.
- 2) Volleyball Canada tie-breaking procedure and rules (with applicable NBIAA guidelines) will govern Height 2.35m.
- 3) All round-robin matches are two straight game matches, while all playoff matches are best two of three matches. All games are played to 25 points (must win by 2 points) except the deciding set which is played to 15 points (must win by 2 points).
- 4) Volleyball New Brunswick certified officials will be used as major officials for all matches. Scorekeepers will also be supplied, however no linespeople will be used for the tournament.
- 5) Following round-robin play, the top two teams in each pool will advance to the playoff round. Teams finishing 1st in each pool will be ranked 1st-3rd (based on games won/lost followed by points for/against) **Top 2 will receive a bye to the Semi-Finals. Teams finishing 2nd in each pool will be ranked 4th-6th (based on games won/lost followed by points for/against).
- 6) Awards will be presented to the top two teams, as well as two "Player of the Games" for the Championship finals.
- 7) Friday's matches will be played at the LB Gym and the Currie Center (located beside the LB Gym). Saturday's matches will all be played at the Currie Center. The Performance Gym is on the 5th floor, while the Rec Gym is located on the 1st floor.
- 8) Coaches, our facilities are large buildings that have many programs operating during the weekend. Please ensure that your team behaves in an appropriate manner at all times, and that they take care of their garbage either as spectators or as players in the bench area after each match...thank-you.
- **NOTE: The Control Centre will be located in the Performance Gym, where results will be posted and ice available in the event of an injury.
